

BID NOTICE AND INVITATION TO BID

Bids are hereby invited for **MARBLE HALL EXTENSION 6 STORMWATER** in EPHRAIM MOGALE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY in Limpopo. The contract entails the construction of the new infrastructure namely, the **stormwater open channels**, **storm water pipes**, **catch pits**, **discharge points**, **repairing and upgrading of the existing paved roads**.

Only bidders who comply with the following requirements are eligible to submit tenders:

- Register with CIDB and having a grading of **5CE or higher**.
- Bids will be evaluated on the 90/10 points system.
- Tenders will be evaluated on functionality with a minimum qualifying score of 60 points.

Only tenderers who can demonstrate that they will have in their employ staff which satisfies EPWP requirements during the contract validity are eligible to submit tenders.

Tender documents will be obtainable as from Thursday the **01 September 2016** at the offices of **EPHRAIM MOGALE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY** (not on site), in **Marble Hall**, upon payment of a non-refundable amount of R550.00. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques made out to EPHRAIM MOGALE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY will be acceptable.

A compulsory site inspection will be held on Monday the **05 September 2016** at **11:00**. Prospective tenderers are requested to meet the Engineer and the Municipal representatives at the **Town Hall** of the Ephraim Mogale Local Municipality, No: 3 Ficus Street in Marble hall. The Engineers will lead all prospective tenderers through the proposed site. Only tenders from tenderers who attended the above site inspection meeting will be considered. **It is compulsory for one partner in an entity intending to bid as a Joint Venture (JV) to attend briefing meeting**

A person who is suitably qualified and experienced to comprehend the implication of the work involved must represent tenderers at the site inspection. If the tenderer or his/her representative does not attend the site meeting, the tender will be disqualified. Tenderers are to arrange their own transport. The tenderer shall have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required scope of the works.

Marble Hall Extension 6 is in Marble Hall approximately 3.0km North-West of Marble Hall town along the N11. Access to the project from the centre of Marble Hall Town (Ephraim Mogale Local Municipal Offices) is obtained by travelling on the N11 road for about 3.0km towards Extension 6 where our project will be.

The co-ordinates are: 24° 57' 50.53" S and 29°16' 45.86" E

All tenders and supporting documents must be sealed in a cover clearly marked "CONTRACT NUMBER: 8/3/219- "MARBLE HALL EXTENSION 6 STORMWATER" and must be deposited in the tender box, at ground floor entrance foyer, Ephraim Mogale Local Municipal office in Marble Hall, not later than 12:00 on 19th September 2016.

Only tenderers who are registered in the relevant category with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) will be considered. The bidding company shall have a CIDB grading designation of 5CE or higher. In cases of companies tendering as JV's it is therefore a requirement that all JV partner provide proof of having registered with the CIDB. Tenderers MUST provide a certified copy of B-BBEE Status Level Verificate for the company and in the case of Joint ventures a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate must be submitted. The bid will be evaluated and adjudicated in accordance with the 90/10 point system as outlined above and in terms of the PPPFA.2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000) and the regulations and the supply chain management policy of the EPHRAIM MOGALE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY.

All bids will remain valid for a period of ninety (90) days after the time and date of opening. Late submissions, telegraphic, telefax or e-mail transmission tenders will not be accepted. EPHRAIM MOGALE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid and reserves the right to accept a tender as a whole or in part.
