

## **EPHRAIM MOGALE LOCAL MUNICIAPLITY**

Tenders are hereby invited from Contractors with necessary experience and compliance documents, have an active CIDB grading of a minimum 4CEPE Or Higher and are in good standing with the South African Revenue Services

Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted and cheques are to be made payable to **Ephraim Mogale Local Municipality**.

The tenders must meet the Engineers at the main entrance of the community hall at the Ephraim Mogale Municipality, for a compulsory Site meeting and Inspection on the 04<sup>th</sup> July 2013, at 11h00 after which Tenderers will be taken to site(s) where project's construction will be taking place. Only tenders from Tenderers who attend the above tender meeting and have signed attendance register shall be considered.

All tenders and supporting documents shall be sealed in an envelope or package clearly marked "Contract No. R/LP/6525/09/14 - UPGRADING OF LEEUWFONTEIN INTERNAL STREETS - PHASE 2.

Duly completed tenders shall be placed in the tender box situated at the main entrance of Ephraim Local Municipality situated in Marble Hall, **not later than 11H00 on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2013**. No Fax or Late tenders will be accepted. The municipality shall adjudicate and award tenders in accordance with the <u>Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 5/2000</u> and revised <u>Preferential Procurement Regulation June 2011</u> on 100 points functionality and on a 90/10 points system, where 90 points are for the price and 10 points for B-BBEE according to the said legislation. Tenders are required to submit valid B-BBEE status level verification certificates.

The Tenderer must have a staff member who has completed, or, is registered for training towards, the NQF level 5 unit standard "Develop and Promote Labour Intensive Construction Strategies".
