1. PURPOSE

The municipality wishes to invite suitably a qualified service provider to provide calculation of the rehabilitation provision for landfill site that fully complies with GRAP 19. The Marble Hall landfill is situated on part of portion 476 of the farm Loskop-Noord 12 JS.

2. BACKGROUND

3.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS
