

Minister's Commitment to eradicate water supply challenges

Water and Environmental Affairs Minister Edna Molewa commit to urgently eradicate the water shortage challenges the Sekhukhune District is facing.

This was stated when addressing communities at TompiSeleka Agricultural and Technological College during the Masibambisane project. The present Flag Boshielo Water purification project as only able to purify and distribute about 8megaliters of water per day and as government we want to increase its capacity to purify 29megaliters of water per day, she said to the applauding community.

The minister updated the communities about the development at the De-Hoop Dam which she indicated that the dam is at its final stage and reticulations infrastructure across the villages are taking place. On the issue around the Moutse areas, Minister indicated that the process of water delivery in the area is on as the Sekhukhune District Municipality is busy with the infrastructures. Not long issue of the water challenges in Sekhukhune area will be a thing of the past and communities will be able to access water on continuous basis, not as it is now when water is available on adhoc basis, she concluded.

The Minister also commits her department to make water available for the agricultural project such as the Masibambisane and others.
